### Introduction

Milton Keynes NHS Trust, now Milton Keynes University Hospital NHS Foundation Trust, is a medium-sized general hospital providing comprehensive acute and specialist services to the growing population of Milton Keynes and surrounding areas. With 550 beds and over 4,000 staff, the hospital serves hundreds of thousands of patients annually and continues to invest in facilities and services to meet evolving healthcare needs. It also houses the country's first independent Medical School in partnership with the University of Buckingham.
